First launched in 2003 as the "Harpeth Hootenanny," the event has grown into one of Middle Tennessee's most anticipated conservation celebrations.

Hosted each September at **River Circle Farm** in Franklin, River Swing blends live performances, dinner, cocktails, and a robust silent auction to create an unforgettable experience.

With more than two decades of impact and over \$2 million raised, River Swing continues to evolve and inspire. This year's event, headlined by **St. Paul and the Broken Bones**, reflects both the joy of gathering and the urgent need to protect Tennessee's globally unique waterways. Each River Swing is a reminder that while the music and celebration may last one night, the work to protect our rivers lasts all year long.
